 - The yeah...buts

Fifth


- Identify viable solutions that
 - Start at right place
 - End at right place
 - Avoid the constraints
- Identify higher level support
 - Sponsors, bill payers, customers, values
 - How will you manage these?

Project Management Steps

Sixth

- Select metrics to measure progress, results and outcomes
 - Performance Measurement
 - Cost Schedule Resources
 - Impact Evaluation
 - The net effect = what happened-what if you had not done the project
 - Outcome Evaluation
 - Project effectiveness and results


Keys to Successful Project Management

- C- Share Control--successful project management happens when the team, customers and stakeholders help.


In developing the approach

Elements of the Plan




Elements of the Plan
 From Requirement + (You add these)




Task== Listing of all deliverables, functions and continuing efforts

Elements of the plan




Process= A controlled series of steps that accomplishes the task

Elements of the plan




Tools= External aids to reduce process time or labor in process performance

Elements of the plan



Essential Work Skills==Team skills, education, training, influencing, understanding, positive conflict resolution, listening and communicating (I + O + C)

Elements of the quality plan
